- Lead peer-teaching workshops to share their knowledge at a Kids Teaching Kids conference event

Participating schools receive:

- Grants of up to \$1000
- Access to comprehensive teaching resources aligned to the Victorian Curriculum 2.0
- Support from the Earthwatch education team
- Support to showcase student work through events and online platforms
